

Additionally, students must paste a cutout on an A4 sized sheet from the source where the word is taken from and highlight the chosen word clearly; attached with **Q.1.**

3) WONDERS OF INDIA

Explore the incredible diversity of India through a creative travelogue! Choose any **one** Indian state and create a beautifully designed travelogue booklet on **A4-size** ruled sheets. Your travelogue should be informative, visually appealing, colorful, pictorial and reflect the rich heritage of the state you chose.

Your travelogue must include the following components:

- **a)** Catchy Title: Give your travelogue a creative and eye-catching title related to the chosen state.
- **b)** Slogan: Frame a short and impactful slogan for the state that you have chosen.
- c) Introduction:
 - **Introductory Jingle:** Write a fun and rhythmic 4-line jingle to begin your travelogue.
 - **Introductory Paragraph:** Write a 100 word introduction about the state its location, significance, and overall charm.

d) Traditional Art and Culture:

- Mention famous dance forms.
- Describe important festivals celebrated in the state.

e) Famous Monuments:

- List important historical monuments.
- Mention architectural styles (e.g., Mughal, Rajput, Dravidian, Colonial, etc.).
- **f) Popular Cuisines:** Name and describe the most famous traditional dishes and sweets.

g) Unique Flora and Fauna:

- Describe notable animals found in the state.
- Mention unique plants or trees.
- Include sanctuaries or national parks present in the state.
- **h) Traditional Costumes:** Describe the traditional clothing worn by men and women in the state.
- i) Interesting Facts: Add 5-6 interesting or lesser-known facts about the state.

Presentation Guidelines:

- Make a booklet using ruled A4-size sheets.
- Use one side of the sheet for written content and the other side for pictures, drawings, or cut-outs.
- Ensure neat layout, clear headings, and colorful visuals.
- Be creative use borders, stickers, or simple doodles to decorate your pages.

Task 1: Model making

Roll no 1-15

Create a model titled "Energy from Nature" to show how we can use natural resources to produce clean energy.

Renewable energy comes from sources like the sun, wind, and water that never run out and do not pollute the environment.

Your model can include features such as a windmill on a hill, solar panels on a house, and a small river with a water wheel. Don't forget to label each part of your model neatly and clearly.

Roll no 16-30

Design a model of an "Eco Transport Park" to show how we can travel in ways that are safe for the Earth.

An eco-friendly transport system uses vehicles and methods that reduce pollution and save energy, such as bicycles, electric cars, and shared rides.

Hint: You can make a park setting include features like bicycle lanes, electric cars, a charging station, Electric train system and trees along the roads—and remember to label all parts of your model clearly.

Roll no 31 - last

Create a model of a sustainable technology using only waste or unused materials—without using energy from nature like solar, wind, or water. Think of useful inventions that make our lives easier while also being kind to the planet. This could be something like a waste-sorting machine, a recycling robot, a clean water device, or even a smart bin.

This activity helps us explore how technology can be used responsibly to reduce pollution, manage waste, and improve daily life—without harming the environment.

NOTE- Along with your model, make a scrapbook of 6–8 pages explaining what you have created. Your scrapbook will tell the story behind your model and show how it helps us live a more sustainable life.

Be neat, colorful, and creative! You can use:

- Drawings
- Photos (or cutouts from magazines/newspapers)
- Labels, arrows, and short descriptions

- Bullet points and captions in your own words

Your Scrapbook Must Include:

- 1) Aims and Objectives (Purpose of your model/what problem does it solve or improve)
- 2) Model Explanation & working (Describe what parts your model has and how it works, Mention how waste materials were used to make it)
- 3) History or Invention of the Product (When or how was this kind of technology first used?, how has it changed over time?"
- 4) Benefits of the model (How does your model help the environment or community?)

Task: 2 MAKE A POSTER/COLLAGE

Instructions:

- Use an A3-sized sheet for your project.
- You can create either a collage or a poster.
- Feel free to use colors or paste pictures to enhance your representation.
- Make sure to use Waste materials such as ice cream sticks, paper straws, bottle caps, and other scrap items to creatively represent the idea of sustainability.

Roll no 1-20

In your poster, introduce the concept of sustainability and the importance of the 3 R's—Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle. Show how these actions can be applied in everyday life to protect the environment. Roll no 20- Last

ACTIVITY - 1

Activity Steps:

- Set a Budget:
- Decide on a total grocery budget.
- Discuss the importance of budgeting and how it helps in managing expenses.
- 1. Create a Grocery List:
 - List common grocery items (e.g., rice, vegetables, dairy) along with estimated quantities and prices.
 - Ensure the total estimated cost is within the set budget.
- 2. Simulate Shopping:
 - "Shop" by selecting items from the list and recording their actual prices.
- 3. Calculate Totals:
 - Add up the actual prices to find the total spent.
 - Subtract the total spent from the budget to determine if there's any money left or if the budget was exceeded.
- 4. Reflect: Talk about strategies to stay within budget, such as choosing less expensive items or adjusting quantities.
- 5. Once the grocery list is complete, calculate the total cost for 5 families using the same
