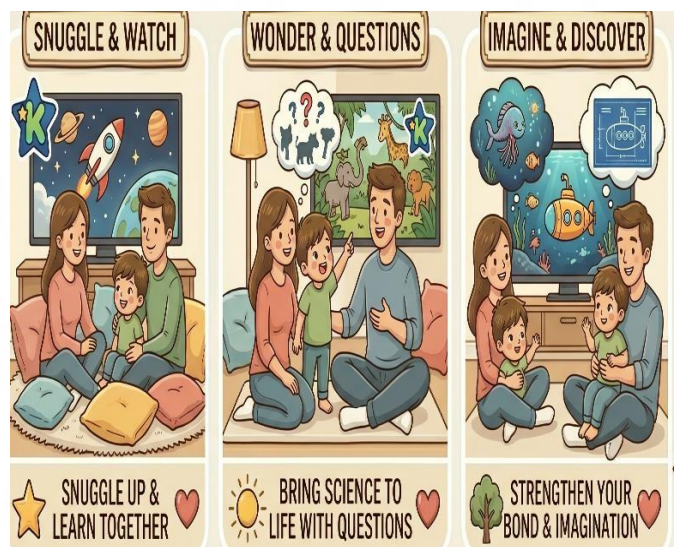

Word Fun

This is a fun learning activity, where kids can learn words very easily.

Activity:

A sand/salt tray is another great tool to use to learn words. The feel of the rough sand or salt helps kinesthetic learners memorize the words.

Things required:

- Some sand/salt or semolina
- Empty Tray

Directions:

Take a bowl of some sand/salt/ semolina.

Spread the sand/salt/ semolina into the empty tray.

- Use index finger, trace the words on the tray as shown in the picture.
- Encourage him/her to speak all the sight words and Group1 Words taught in the class, while tracing them.

Activities

Hopscotch Game :

Write down numbers on the floor and ask your child to first identify and then hop to the number you will say. For example, when you will say, "Hop to the number that comes before 5," your child has to identify that the number is 4 and then hop towards the number.



Number Line Race:

Create a number line with the set of ten numbers like. 1 to 10, 10 to 20 on the floor using tape or chalk.

Child takes turns rolling 2 dice and moving that many spaces.

To practice "before" and "after", ask child what number they were on before their turn and what number they will be on after their turn.





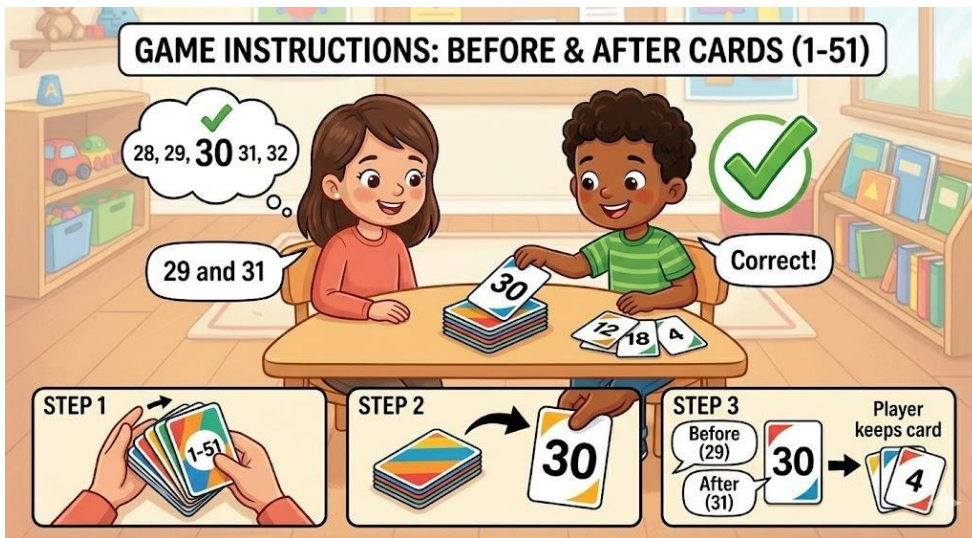
Spot the Numbers

Create flash cards with numbers 1 to 51.

Shuffle the cards and place them face down.

Players take turns drawing a card and saying the number that comes before and after the drawn number.

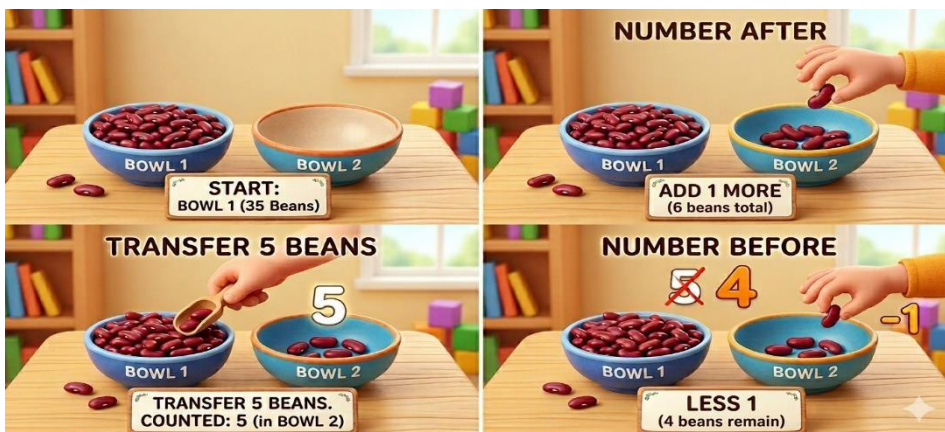
For example, if the player draws 30, they should say 29 and 31. If the player answers correctly, they keep the card.



Number Neighbours Activity

Help your child understand how adding one gives the next number and taking away one gives the previous number through this hands-on practice.

Take two bowls. Put 30-35 kidney beans in one bowl. Transfer 5 beans to the second bowl and count them. Now, add one more bean to 5 to show that it becomes 6 (number after). Then, take away one bean from 5 to show that it becomes 4 (number before). Repeat with different numbers.

1. **Toast the Bread**

Now comes the fun part—arrange veggies to make different expressions:



- **Eyes:** Use cucumber slices + olive rings
- **Nose:** Small carrot piece
- **Mouth:** Tomato or capsicum slice
- **Hair:** Coriander leaves or carrot sticks
- **Beard:** Cauliflower florets
- **Glasses:** Thin capsicum rings

4. **Get Creative**

Make different "portraits" — funny, serious, surprised—just like in the picture.

5. **Serve Fresh**

Best enjoyed immediately so the toast stays crisp.
